Implementation of CBSE Curriculum Changes for Class IX (Session 2026–27)

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), in alignment with the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** and the **National Curriculum Framework for School Education (NCFSE) 2023**, has introduced significant curriculum reforms for students entering **Class IX** from the **academic session 2026–27**.

These changes aim to provide students with greater flexibility, deeper conceptual understanding, holistic development, and opportunities to pursue subjects based on their interests and future aspirations. The curriculum also emphasizes competency-based learning, skill development, well-being, and experiential education.

In accordance with CBSE guidelines, the following changes will be implemented for Class IX from Session **2026–27**:

Curriculum Structure

1. Languages

- **R1 (Language 1): English**
- **R2 (Language 2): Hindi**
- **R3 (Language 3): Sanskrit**

2. Mathematics

All students will study **Mathematics** as part of the core curriculum.

Additionally, students who demonstrate aptitude and interest may **opt for Advanced Mathematics**, providing enhanced exposure to higher-order mathematical concepts.

3. Science

All students will study **Science** as part of the core curriculum.

Students with a strong interest in scientific learning may also choose **Advanced Science**, enabling deeper conceptual understanding and preparation for future STEM pathways.

4. Social Science

Social Science will continue as a compulsory subject in accordance with the revised curriculum.

5. Physical Education and Well-being

The existing Physical Education programme has been strengthened to include:

- **Sports and Games**
- **Fitness Education**
- **Yoga and Wellness Practices**

This enhancement aims to promote physical fitness, emotional well-being, mindfulness, and healthy lifestyle habits.

6. Vocational Education

To strengthen skill-based learning, the school is introducing: **Kaushal Vikas (Vocational Education)**

The programme will help students develop practical skills, creativity, problem-solving abilities, and career awareness in alignment with NEP 2020.

7. Optional Subject

Students will have the opportunity to study: **Information Technology (IT)**

This subject will enhance digital literacy and technological competence.

8. Computational Thinking and Artificial Intelligence

As recommended by CBSE, **Computational Thinking (CT) and Artificial Intelligence (AI)** will be introduced as **compulsory modules** integrated into the curriculum. These modules will help students develop logical reasoning, computational problem-solving, responsible use of AI, and future-ready digital competencies.

Assessment Pattern

The revised curriculum places greater emphasis on:

- Competency-based learning
- School-based Internal Assessment
- Experiential and project-based learning
- Continuous evaluation of conceptual understanding and application of knowledge

The objective is to move beyond rote learning and encourage critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, communication, and problem-solving.
