Subject: Registration for CBSE Class XII Supplementary Examination 2026

Dear Parents and Students,

In accordance with *CBSE Circular No. CBSE/COORD/REGULAR/SUPPL/2026* dated 30 June 2026, the following instructions are issued regarding the Class XII Supplementary Examination 2026.

1. Eligible Students

The following students are eligible to apply:

- Students placed in the Compartment category in the CBSE Class XII Board Examination 2026.
- Students who have passed the Class XII Board Examination 2026 and wish to improve their performance in one subject (only in the subjects notified by CBSE for improvement).

2. Registration Process

Eligible students must contact the school office immediately to register for the Supplementary Examination.

Only those students whose applications are submitted online by the school to CBSE will be permitted to appear for the examination.

3. Important Dates

Registration Window: 6th of July 2026 report to school at 9 am sharp.

Examination Fee

₹320 per subject (for schools in India).

The prescribed fee must be deposited with the school on 6th of July (Please bring the exact change)

Date of Examination

Class XII Supplementary Examination: Tuesday, 28 July 2026

Improvement of Performance

Improvement is permitted only in one subject already appeared for in the Main Examination and only for the subjects notified by CBSE.

Admit Card

Admit Cards will be issued separately by CBSE.

Students must collect their Admit Cards from the school once they are released.

Instructions for Compartment Candidates

Students placed in the Compartment category must remain in regular contact with the school and complete all registration formalities.

Parents are requested to proactively verify that their ward's registration has been successfully completed, even if contacted by the school.

Best Score Policy

CBSE follows the Best Score Policy. If a student appears for improvement and secures higher marks, the higher score will be treated as final. If the marks obtained in the improvement examination are lower than the original marks, the original marks will remain unchanged. This policy ensures that students receive a fair opportunity to improve their performance without any disadvantage.

Important Reminder

No applications will be accepted after 8 July 2026, with or without late fee. Therefore, all eligible students and their parents must ensure timely completion of the registration process.

Parents are requested to extend their full cooperation in ensuring that all formalities are completed within the stipulated time and to encourage their wards to prepare sincerely for the Supplementary Examination.
