Activity: Create a Detailed Political Map of India with a Focus on Sikkim and Delhi

2. **Highlight:** Shade **Sikkim** and **Delhi** in bright colors. Label **Gangtok** (Sikkim's capital).
3. **Mountains:** Mark **Himalayas** (near Sikkim) and **Aravalli Hills** (near Delhi).
4. **Borders:** Label **China** and **Nepal** (bordering Sikkim), and **Haryana & Uttar Pradesh** (around Delhi).

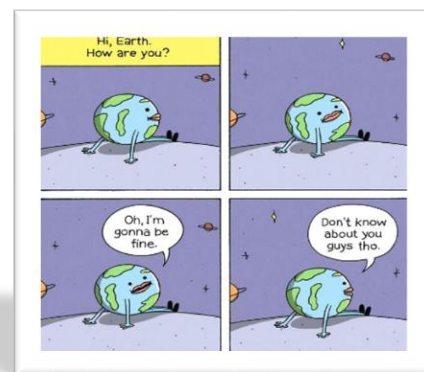
Collection of the seeds of different fruits/vegetables eaten by you in your summer vacations.

2. Record: Capture short clips with smartphone or camera, including landscapes, family, and fun activities.
3. Choose editing software: Select from Canva, iMovie, Adobe Premiere Rush, or other options.
4. Edit: Trim and arrange clips, add transitions, effects, text, and music.
5. Finalize and export: Review, make final edits, and export in suitable format.

Tips: Keep video short (1-2 minutes), use mix of fast-paced and slow-motion shots, and be creative!
