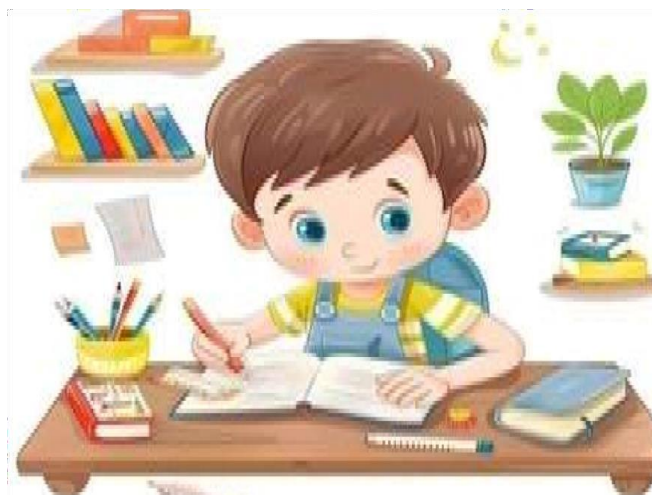

## Task-1

### **Under EBSB (Art Integration-Paired with Sikkim)**

#### English

Language is fun!

Pick out any 10 English words used commonly in our daily life (like good morning, hello, thank you, etc). Translate them into any one language spoken in Delhi and Sikkim and learn.

#### Maths

Shape Art – Monuments of Delhi & Landscapes of Sikkim

- Students recreate Lotus Temple or India Gate (Delhi) and mountains or monasteries (Sikkim) using only 2D shapes (circles, rectangles, triangles).
- Label how many shapes were used.
- Discuss which shapes appear most in each scene.
- Fold their art to check line symmetry.

#### Science

- **Project: “Wings of Sikkim and Delhi.”**
- In these holidays, let's spread our imagination and explore the colourful skies of Sikkim and Delhi. Students can find information about any 3 birds (including state bird) that are found in Sikkim and Delhi. Draw an outline map of both states and paste in the pictures of birds found here. Mention their names also.

#### Social Studies

Make a colourful presentation and compare the following for Delhi and Sikkim.

- Include two pictures and information about its popular tourist attractions, cuisine, special flora and fauna, clothes, culture and festivals.
- Make a meaningful presentation and label each picture pasted.

## Task-2

### English

#### **Verb Adventure Journal**

- For 6 days during the holidays, everyday choose one activity you did (e.g., played a game, baked cookies, cleaned your room).
- Make a drawing in your journal and write 2-3 sentences describing what you did.
- Underline or highlight all the verbs (action words) in your sentences. Example: I baked cookies with my mom. We mixed the batter and placed it in the oven. (Verbs: baked, mixed, placed)

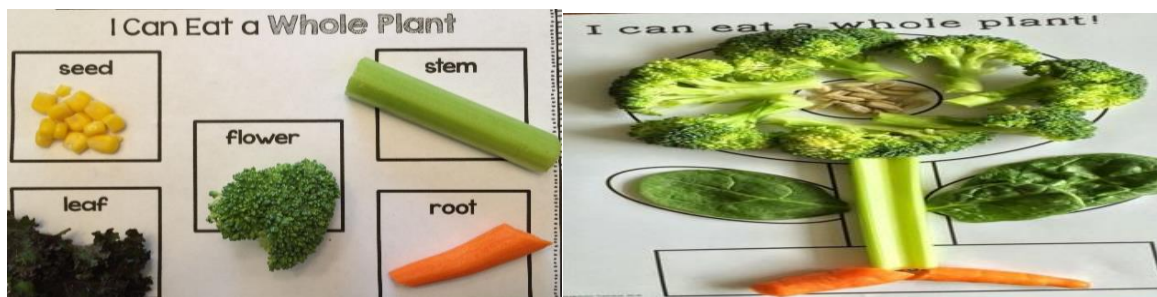
### Maths
