- Submit the folder in the second week of July.



Follow these step-by-step guide to creating a Scratch project about "My Holiday Story":

Step 1: Plan Your Story

- Think about your holiday experiences
- Decide on a storyline or theme
- Jot down some ideas for characters, settings, and events

Step 2: Create a New Project

- Open Scratch and click on "Create"
- Choose a suitable backdrop for your story

Step 3: Add Characters

- Click on "Sprites" and choose a character that fits your story
- Use the paint editor to customize your character or create a new one

Step 4: Add Dialogue

- Use the "say" block to make your character speak
- Type in your holiday story dialogue

Step 5: Add Actions

- Use motion blocks (e.g., "move 10 steps") to make your character move
- Use looks blocks (e.g., "change costume") to change your character's appearance

Step 6: Add Sound Effects

- Use sound blocks (e.g., "play sound") to add music or sound effects

Step 7: Create a Sequence

- Use the blocks to create a sequence of events for your story
- Experiment with different block combinations

Step 8: Test and Refine

- Test your project to make sure it works smoothly
- Refine your project to make it more engaging and fun.
