S. St. - Development - JUL & AUG

Hindi - Culture and Costumes - MAR & APR

Science - Flora and Fauna - SEPT & OCT

Art and craft & Music - Various forms of Native art and music.- - NOV & DEC

- This is a Competency based Group Project.
- Research extensively about culture, cuisine, economy, tourism, festivals, flora and fauna, architechture, monuments etc. of Sikkim and Delhi both to ensure accuracy.
- All visuals should be creative (Collage, sketches, beautification) COMPLETE COPY PASTE OF A SINGLE IMAGE IS NOT ALLOWED
- The last page should present the group members names who have contributed towards making the calendar.
- Marks will be allotted for visual appeal, collaboration, relevance and timely submission by each subject teacher.
- Compiling of the final work will be done on working day in the first week of July after the summer holidays.
- Each group will get their calendars spiral bound and submit by the 10th of July.
